Once enrolled in the program, landowners have 9 months to thin the stand. If the stand is not thinned during this time period, the landowner will be dropped from the program. All Mississippi forestry best management practices (BMPs) are to be followed. The MS Forestry Commission will review the claim, and, upon approval, issue a cost share payment to the landowner. The landowner must agree to follow the approved forest stewardship management plan for at least 5 years following thinning. Each approved tract is subject to inspection by state or federal crews before, during, and after the thinning to ensure that all conditions of the program are being followed.
